# **ENDOMETRIN Patient Info Sheet**

ENDOMETRIN is a vaginal insert that contains the hormone progesterone. ENDOMETRIN is for women who need extra progesterone while undergoing treatment in an Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) cycle.

Progesterone is one of the hormones essential for helping you to become and to stay pregnant. Depending on your treatment protocol, you may need to use progesterone supplementation. If you are undergoing ART treatment, your doctor may prescribe ENDOMETRIN to provide the progesterone your body needs.

# What does ENDOMETRIN do?

ENDOMETRIN may be given to help prepare the uterine lining for embryo implantation and early pregnancy. If you are undergoing ART treatment, your doctor may prescribe ENDOMETRIN to provide progesterone support.

# How should I use ENDOMETRIN?

Use ENDOMETRIN exactly as prescribed. Place an ENDOMETRIN insert in your vagina with the disposable applicator provided. Do not use other vaginal products when using ENDOMETRIN.

### Who should not use ENDOMETRIN?

# Do not use ENDOMETRIN if you:

- Are allergic to any ingredient in ENDOMETRIN. See the full <u>Prescribing Information</u> for a complete list of ingredients
- Have unusual vaginal bleeding that has not been evaluated by a doctor
- Currently have or have had liver problems
- Have or have had blood clots in the legs, lungs, eyes, or elsewhere in your body

#### What are the most common side effects?

Common side effects of Endometrin included pelvic/abdominal cramping, bloating and constipation. Other reported side effects include headache, nausea, tiredness, and vaginal spotting. Vaginal products with progesterone may also cause vaginal irritation, burning and discharge.

These are not all the possible side effects of ENDOMETRIN. For more information, ask your healthcare provider or pharmacist.

# **How should I store ENDOMETRIN?**

ENDOMETRIN may be stored at room temperature and is safe to use until the printed expiration date.
